Manual Part 2 Safety Advice

Thank you!

Thank you for choosing a Dancover patio cover. We hope that you will enjoy the product. For you to get the most out of your new patio cover, we recommend that you read this Safety Advice carefully before you assemble and start using the product!

Please note that it is your responsibility to comply with local rules and regulations and to ensure that the patio cover is assembled correctly according to the enclosed manual. It is very important that you assemble all parts according to the instructions and fasten the patio cover to the wall and to the base with the enclosed anchors or similar fittings. See paragraph Fixtures and fittings below!

Do not skip any parts or any steps.

We also recommend that you keep this manual somewhere safe so that you can use it when necessary.

Attention!

Before you start to assemble the patio cover, please be sure to check that everything you need is there according to the list of parts in this manual. Be sure that you have received everything and that nothing is missing or damaged. In case of missing or damaged parts, please fill out a Claim to Dancover before you start assembling the patio cover!

Important!

Please follow the instructions as listed in this manual and start the assembly by sorting the parts and check against the list of contents. For safety purposes we strongly recommend that the product is assembled by at least two people.

Before you start to assemble the product!

This product should be assembled on a solid base such as concrete, wood, or asphalt and anchored to the wall as well as the base when assembled. Choose your site carefully before beginning assembly. Sort the parts and check according to the contents parts list. The base for the patio cover must be level - as a minimum under the posts. Use only the parts registered in the content list, some parts may be surplus.

Fixtures and fittings

Be sure to tighten all screws when the assembly is complete. Please note: make sure to use the correct wall anchoring kit as well as anchors for the posts. In general, we supply an anchoring kit for concrete walls only. Other wall types need an accordant wall fixation kit. It is up to you to ensure that the right anchors and more are being used. If you are in doubt, please consult a professional.

If you use a wrong anchor and similar, you may create a dangerous situation in case of bad weather and the warranty may not apply in general.

Attention!

Some parts have sharp edges so please be careful when handling components. Always wear gloves, shoes and safety goggles during assembly. Do not attempt to assemble the patio cover in windy or wet conditions.

Dispose of all packaging responsibly and be careful with the plastic bags and keep them away from small children as they pose a choking hazard. In general, keep children away from the assembly area.

Do not attempt to assemble the patio cover if you are tired, have taken drugs, medications or alcohol, or if you are prone to dizzy spells. When using a stepladder or power tools, ensure that you are follow the manufacturer's safety advice. Do not climb or stand on the roof of the patio cover or lean heavy items against the posts. Please note that this product was designed and produced to be a patio cover only!

If you at some point want to clean your patio cover, use a mild detergent solution and rinse with cold clean water. Do not use acetone, abrasive cleaners, or others special detergents to clean the patio cover.

Weather conditions

When the patio cover is assembled and in use, keep the roof and gutters free of snow, dirt, and leaves. Too much wet and heavy snow on the roof can damage the patio cover so make sure that you remove wet snow whenever needed. Water will run off the patio cover by itself.

The patio cover must be placed on a solid and level base like concrete, flagstones, wood, or asphalt. Choose your site carefully before beginning assembly. During assembly use a soft material under the parts to avoid scratches and damages. When the patio cover has been assembled, it is important that you fasten the patio cover to the wall as well as to the base with anchors or similar to avoid accidents in windy weather and bad weather in general. See paragraph Fixtures and fittings!

Insurance

Make sure to check whether your patio cover is covered by your house contents insurance or similar.

Warranty information

Dancover warranty applies only to the normal use of the product, normal wear and tear excepted, in accordance with written use instructions or manual. The warranty does not apply to damage caused by accident, abuse, misuse, or modification of the product.
